## Art or Band option

Just a reminder that students in grade 5-8 in the fall have the option of band or art. If a student took art or band in the past they may still switch for the upcoming year. Forms need to be signed and returned ASAP.

## Volunteer information

For the **2025-2026** school year if you are looking to volunteer in any capacity at the school you will be required to complete a criminal records check, child abuse registry, confidentiality letter and volunteer agreement form. You are also required to complete Respect in Schools training on line and return a copy of the certificate to school.

Please contact the school and we can send home a package with your child/(ren) or drop in to pick one up. There is no fee if you are volunteering and we have a letter to attach with the documents. In the instructions the criminal records check can now be emailed. Packages may be picked up at school and the child abuse registry is to be returned to the office so that we may process it and mail it out. Once you fill in the paperwork, it is good until your child is no longer at Balmoral School. We will **not be taking applications** after May 8, 2026. It is a very busy time of the year. Get your checks done early to avoid being disappointed. Thank you.

## Grade 4-5 news:






